Our focus this term is 'Creatures of our world' and we are hoping you will be able to help your child make a poster about their favourite creature which they will share at kindergarten during group times. The term overview and weekly program is already in the Learning Journal with details of some of the stories and songs we will be using, so take time to have a look. During the term I will be attending a Nature Based Learning Study Tour in Scotland investigating forest preschools (the children do all of their learning out of doors). I have been very interested in this way of working with young children and I am very excited to be able to organise this trip. I will be taking 4 weeks long service leave for this study tour from Monday May 18th and returning Monday June 15th, During my absence I am delighted to inform you that Louise Montesi will be the Acting Director and Crystal Morphett (who has been doing relief teaching during Term 1) will be working as the teacher. The children have already formed a warm relationship with Crystal so I know that they will enjoy having her as their teacher.
